Clinical Notes for 26.Dec.2007 - FD

Necropsy 2007-0093

Gross findings: good body condition/haircoat, both rear feet nails torn/frayed, 3 bullet entry wounds present- left and right side of chest, and dorsum frontal area of skull. thoracic trauma- lung, heart, free/clotted blood within the thoracic cavity. GI tract, kidneys, liver, spleen, pancreas, bladder, repro tract, brain- NSF Tissue set collected for histo to NWZP, similar tissue set collected, saved inhouse fresh and fixed, brain sent to SFPH for rabies testing 3 total small arms caliber bullets recovered- chest cavity, thoracic vert, left frontal sinus to be sent to SFPD forensics
